JOHN 13:22-24 NIV

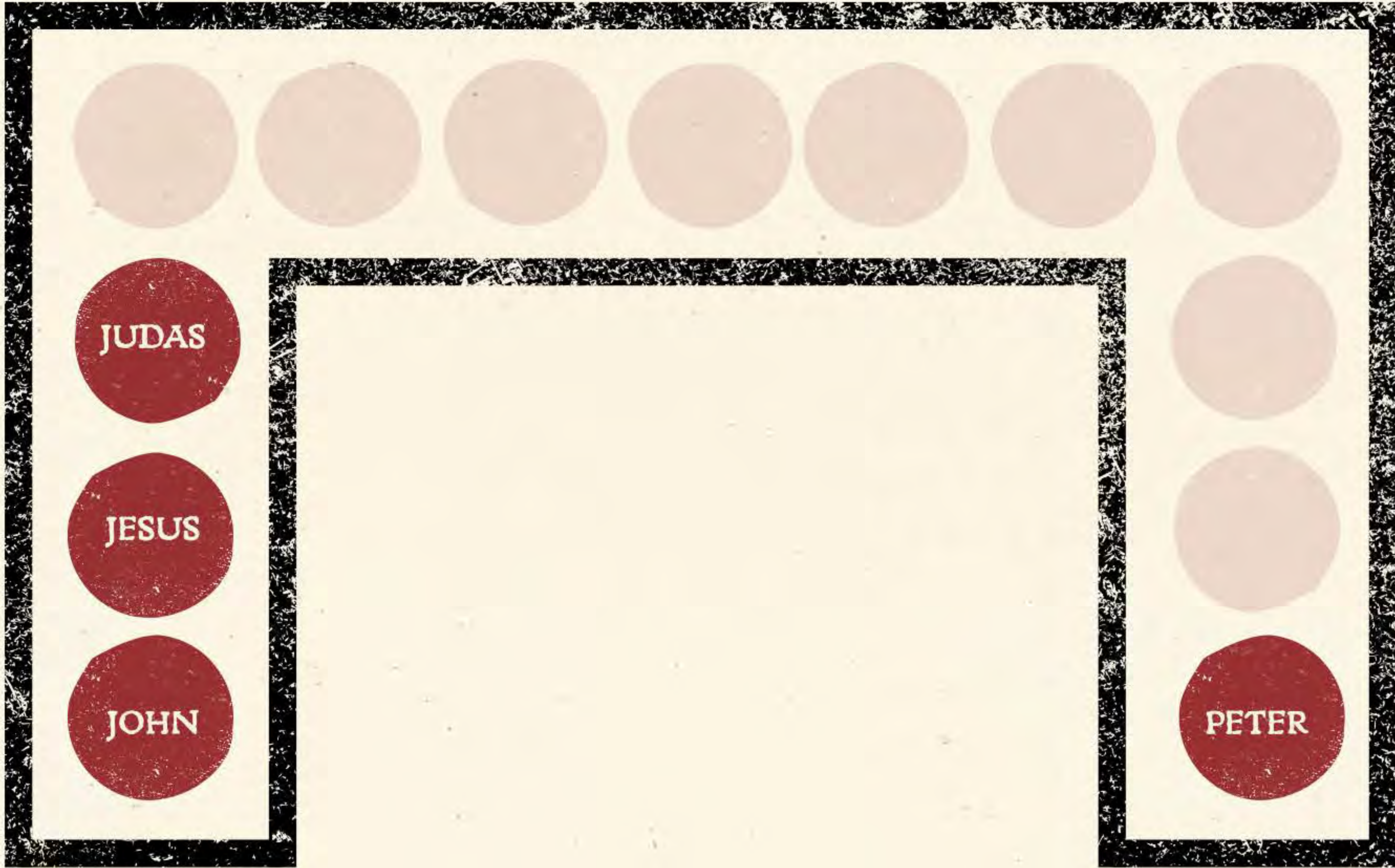
His disciples stared at one another, at a loss to know which of them he meant.

Peter motioned to this disciple and said, “Ask him which one he means.”

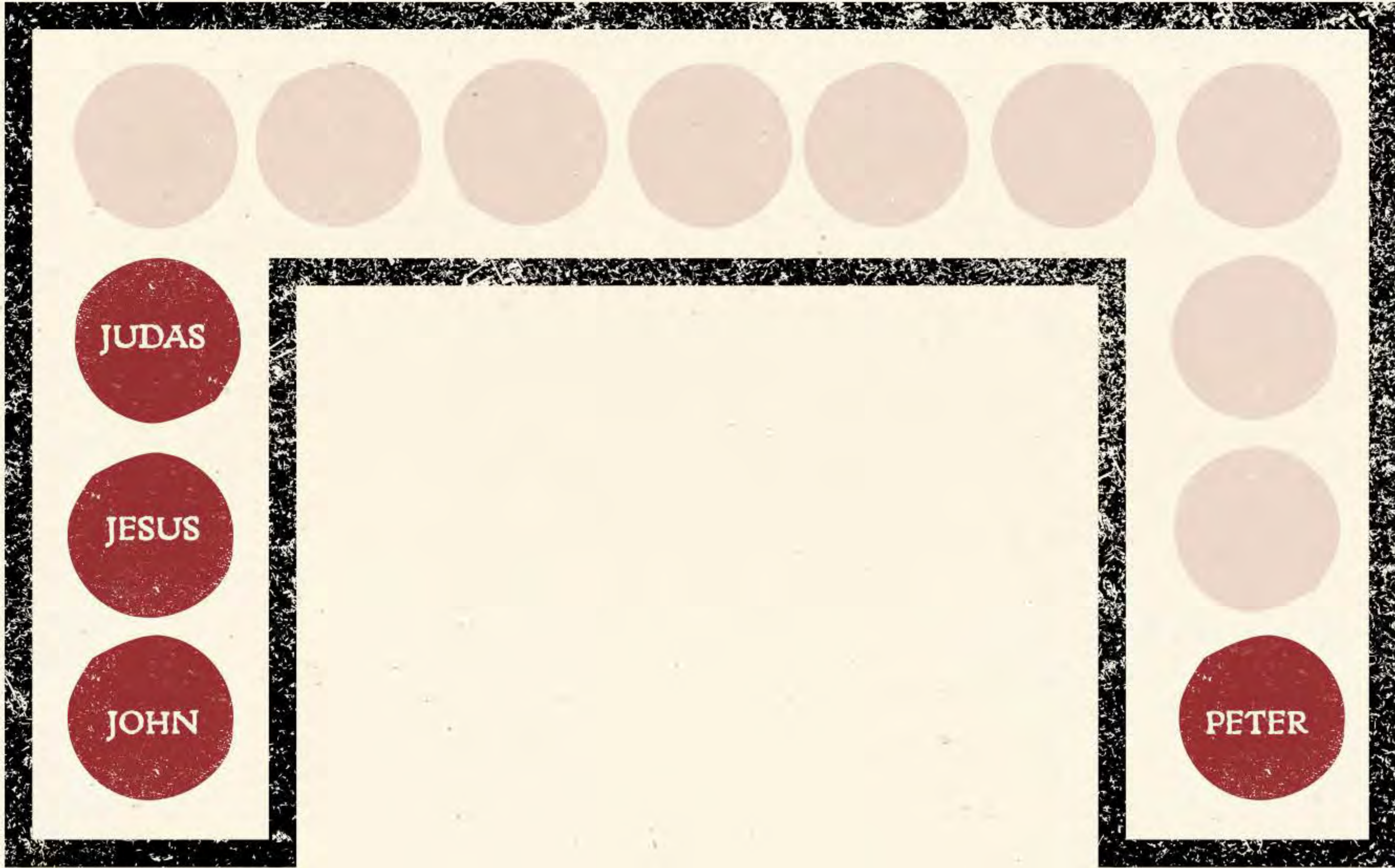
