



## TONGUES

If someone speaks in a tongue, it should be two, or at the most three, one after the other, and someone must interpret. <sup>28</sup> But if there is no interpreter, he should be silent in the church. Let him speak to himself and to God.

## PROPHECY

Two or three prophets should speak and the others should evaluate what is said. <sup>30</sup> And if someone sitting down receives a revelation, the person who is speaking should conclude. <sup>31</sup> For you can all prophesy one after another, so all can learn and be encouraged. <sup>32</sup> Indeed, the spirits of the prophets are subject to the prophets, <sup>33</sup> for God is not characterized by disorder but by peace...

## 1 Corinthians 14:33b-35 NET

As in all the churches of the saints, <sup>34</sup> the women should be silent in the churches, for they are not permitted to speak. ## **SPIRIT-FILLED** GATHERINGS



### **1 Corinthians 14:36-40** ESV

Did the word of God begin with you, or did it come to you alone? <sup>37</sup> If anyone considers himself a prophet or spiritual person, he should acknowledge that what I write to you is the Lord's command. <sup>38</sup> If someone does not recognize this, he is not recognized. <sup>39</sup> So then, brothers and sisters, be eager to prophesy, and do not forbid anyone from speaking in tongues. <sup>40</sup> And do everything in a decent and orderly manner.
