

REFRAMING SPIRITUAL GIFTS

1 Corinthians 12-14

12:1-11 | True Spirituality is submission to Jesus

12:12-31 | Christ made us to need each other

3:1-13 | The highest aim is love

14:1-25 | The gifts exist to build up the body

4:26-40 | The gifts must be exercised in an orderly way

TONGUES DEFINED

The supernatural enablement to speak another human language

The expression of love and wonder in inarticulate sounds

1 Corinthians 14:27-28 NIV

PROPHECY DEFINED

Spirit-inspired, authoritative words from God that are without error

Spirit-inspired, insightful words that may be in error

ABSOLUTE PROHIBITION CONTEXTUAL CORRECTION NOT PAUL'S WORDS

1 Corinthians 14:36-38 NIV

Or did the word of God originate with you? Or are you the only people it has reached? ³⁷ If anyone thinks they are a prophet or otherwise gifted by the Spirit, let them acknowledge that what I am writing to you is the Lord's command. ³⁸ But if anyone ignores this, they will themselves be ignored.



1 Corinthians 14:39-40 NIV

Therefore, my brothers and sisters, be eager to prophesy, and do not forbid speaking in tongues. ⁴⁰ But everything should be done in a fitting and orderly way.
